Dr K.N. Tripathy, member, while engaging with quality improvement in classroom teaching requested to provide computers to the Department of Commerce in view of the ongoing CBSC syllabus, in Degree as well as PG Commerce classes to which the Principal Dr Mallik clarified that such facilities have already been provisioned from current academic session and other such facilities have been made for other Departments under the ensuing World Bank funded project.

While appreciating the "Plantation Campaign" carried out in and around the campus, the GB resolved to impress upon the Forest Department to include more economically important, durable and hard timber wood plant species

among other saplings, during future plantation programmes.

13 It was suggested by the Collector to obtain necessary permission from Competent Authorities and experts for felling of old trees inside the campus. Chairman insisted that the legal provisions be complied with.

14 The Executive Engineer, PWD, assured to do the necessary leveling of the college playground to make it ready before the College Annual Sports scheduled

for the second week of January, 2019.

For laying the approach road to the ITDA hostel, it was decided to write to the PA, ITDA and as it needs evacuation of the unauthorized occupants, the Principal was advised to requisition the official services of the District

Administration in this regard.

The CCTV installation by the Government was highly appreciated and the GB resolved to have them installed at potentially vulnerable points only. Further, the Biometric Device installation under OHEPEE (Odisha Higher Education Program for Excellence and Equity), a World Bank initiative, while being appreciated, it was advised by the Chairman to ensure utmost care for the maintenance and safe upkeep of the device to avoid possible misuse.

17 The different Departmental Seminars, Conferences and extra-mural talks conducted by the College was appreciated and acknowledged that such activities

help promote academic quality and excellence.

Sri S.K. Nayak of JK Paper Mills, Rayagada urged to create an active Industry-Academia interface, a platform that will enable students to have practical industrial experience by way of undertaking industrial study tours while at the same time creating employment opportunities by Career Counseling and Placement Workshops through collaboration and consultancy.

19 The Expenditure statements of the 16th GB meeting held on 25th Aug, 2018 was

approved after due deliberation.

The Resolutions of the Examination, Finance and Development Committees of the College between 25.08.2018 and 18.12.2018 were approved.

21 It was suggested by the Principal to have the next GB meeting in the first week of
